When the subject (主語) is **third-person singular**¹¹ in the **simple present tense**¹², we add an extra '-s' or '-es' to the verb.

Sarah plays the piano and watches TV on Sundays.

For the negative statements, we add 'does not' to the verb instead13.

Tiffany does not like coffee.

For the verbs to be and verbs to have, we change the form to 'is' and 'has'.

@ The baby is happy. She has a lot of toys to play with.
