Cooper had an **unusual**¹ **experience**² last Saturday. Look at the pictures below carefully. Listen to the story and **rearrange**³ them in the correct order.



We use **'can'** to talk about what one is **able**⁴ to do; and **'cannot'** to talk about what one is not able to do.

e.g. Susan **can** sing songs.

e.g. Anna **cannot** (= can't) dance.



We use **'could'** as the past tense form of 'can'. We also use **'couldn't'** as the past tense form of 'cannot'.

e.g. Diana **could** swim well at the age of ten.

e.g. When Tommy was four, he **couldn't** tie his shoelaces.
