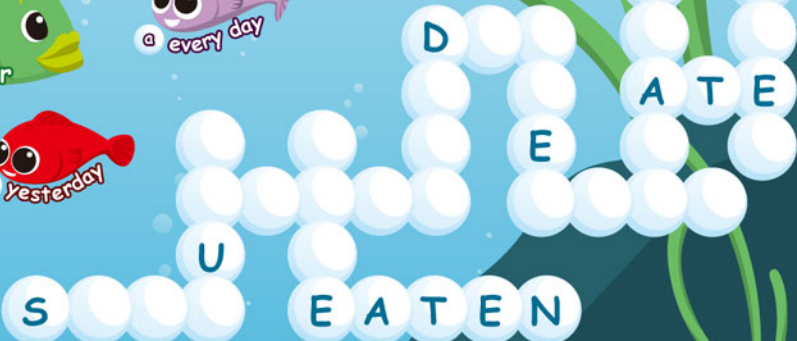

We use the **present perfect tense** to talk about an action that happened at an **unspecified**<sup>4</sup> time in the past. We use **has/have** and the **past participle** in the present perfect tense.

e.g. I **have been** to Beijing three times.
