Sentence patterns

1. It is + adjective + to-infinitive

Example: <u>It is safer to ride</u> on cycling tracks instead of the roads.

2. I find it + adjective + to-infinitive

Example: I find it troublesome to wear a helmet.

3. Present participle clause

Example: Turning right to avoid hitting the dog. I bumped into a tree and hurt my knees.

4. be + too + adjective + to-infinitive

Example: The cycle track <u>was too narrow</u> for two cyclists <u>to use</u> at the same time.

5. If-conditional (Past unreal conditional):

Example: If I had paid attention to the weather report, I would not have gone cycling that evening.

(If-clause; past perfect tense) (Main clause; would have + past participle)
