

Do you know the story of Wong Kam-po, the Hong Kong cycling legend? He is the first Hong Kong cyclist to win the world championship. Many people started cycling because of his story. I started cycling 10 years ago because of him too. In Hong Kong, it is not hard to get onto a bicycle and ride on it. But it is not that easy if you want to cycle safely.

_____ (ii)

To do well in cycling, you must have good control of your body. When you change direction, you need to be well balanced. You have to balance your body with your arms and legs so that you will not fall easily. You may see some experienced cyclists standing while cycling. Actually, that requires even better balance and coordination as the bicycle will move from side to side. Cyclists need to use more strength on their arms and legs.

_____ (iii)

After maintaining a good balance, you will enjoy the excitement of cycling. You can feel the cool breeze on your face and you will be **amazed** by the fun when you are on the bike.

_____ (iv)

Cycling is a fun sport, but it still has its dangers. Beginners may step too hard on the pedals and **it** can cause knee pain easily. Also, if you speed up without balancing your body, you may fall from the bicycle. So, remember to keep the balance all the time and wear a helmet and knee pads to prevent injuries!
