Answering Strategy

- Text type and format This is a magazine article. Think of a title that reflects your stance clearly and would prompt readers to read on. For the content, choose 2-3 areas from the mind map. There is no fixed format, but the opening, the main body and the ending should be clearly differentiated by each's content.
- 2. Genre This is a commentary and a piece of expository writing. Write either for or against the statement that popular culture has negative effects on young people. Defend your stance with concrete examples from current affairs.
- 3. Language and formality The tone and language of an article on an important social issue should be earnest and formal. Make your points politely and logically, so as to convince the readers.
- 4. Organisation State your writing purpose and stance in the opening paragraph. In each of the following paragraphs, give one reason for your stance (topic sentence) and support it with reasonings and examples (supporting details). End by reinforcing your position. Organise the paragraphs, and sentences in each paragraph, with cohesive devices.
- 5. Topic and vocabulary The topic of this article is popular culture and adolescent life. Draw on your own experience. Also refer to the following vocabulary for suggestions about ideas.
