

### Answering Strategy

1. Text type and format – This is a blog entry. There is no fixed format, but the opening, main body and closing should be clearly differentiated by each's content. Write in the first person. Title the entry in a way that reflects the content.
2. Genre – This is a piece of narrative and descriptive writing. Narrate the visit and describe any memorable happenings. Also describe how you feel about the experience as a whole.
3. Language and formality – The language of a blog entry can be personal and informal. Make many uses of terms in radio broadcasting. The tone may be a little excited, since the experience is new to the writer. Write in the simple past tense when describing the visit.
4. Organisation – Begin by narrating how you came to make the visit. Then describe the tour in the radio station. Talk about an unexpected event. Make sure the duties of a DJ are mentioned. End with something about your feelings towards the visit. Organise the paragraphs, and sentences in each paragraph, with cohesive devices.
5. Topic and vocabulary – The topic of this blog entry is radio broadcasting. Draw on your own experience. Also refer to the following vocabulary for suggestions about ideas.
