Answering Strategy

- Language and formality The language of an essay aiming to convince should be formal. The messages should be delivered straightforwardly and in an assured tone. Use the present tense for actual and possible situations. Use rhetorical questions at times to emphasise points that you want emphasised.
- 4. Organisation Begin by describing the problem caused by fast food and stating your stance. In each of the following paragraphs, present one argument (topic sentence) and strengthening examples (supporting details). End by restating your stance. Suggest alternatives if you are against the motion. Organise the paragraphs, and sentences in each paragraph, with cohesive devices.
