## Answering Strategy

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- Text type and format This is a thank you letter. Begin the letter with 'Dear Mr Kimura and all staff'. To show the recipients friendliness, end with a casual complimentary close like 'Love / Best wishes, Mandy Lau'. Write in the first person.
- Genre This is a piece of narrative and expressive writing. Show gratefulness to the recipients
  by giving an account of how much they have helped you throughout the scheme and how you
  feel about it.
- 3. Language and formality The language of a thank you letter to coworkers who have given you support should be informal but polite. Formulaic expressions of gratitude are a little awkward, and so unnecessary. Instead, write in a friendly and grateful tone. Use the past tense for what have happened throughout the scheme. Use the present tense for the benefits you have received from it.
- 4. Organisation Begin by drawing attention to the fact that the scheme is coming to an end, and that you want to give thanks. In the following paragraphs, talk about the difficulties you had, how the school has helped you and how you have benefited from the experience. At the end, give thanks again and wish your recipients well. Organise the paragraphs, and sentences in each paragraph, with cohesive devices.
- 5. Topic and vocabulary The topic of this letter is travel, working abroad, and friendship. Draw on your own experience. Also refer to the following vocabulary for suggestions about ideas.
