

### Answering Strategy

1. Text type and format – You are asked to write a magazine article to express your personal opinions on a specific issue or problem. A title related to your standpoint should be given at the beginning. Arguments for your standpoint should be presented in paragraphs.
2. Genre – It is an argumentative and expository writing. You are expected to argue for or against 3D movies and VR movies with supporting details and examples.
3. Language and formality – Since the purpose of the article is to share your opinions on the given statement with your schoolmates, the use of language can be semi-formal and the tone should be objective. To share your own views, you can use first person pronouns.
4. Organisation – Clearly show your standpoint for or against 3D movies and VR movies at the beginning and reiterate your views in the last paragraph. In the main body, give convincing and objective reasons with examples or from your own experiences to support your arguments. You can use cohesive devices to link up the sentences and paragraphs to make the article more convincing.
5. Topic and vocabulary – The theme of this magazine article is 3D movies and VR movies. You should have enough relevant ideas and vocabulary items for this topic. You can refer to the following ideas and vocabulary items.
