

Answering Strategy

1. Text type and format – You are asked to complete an entry in a booklet. There is no fixed format for a booklet entry. But, for this question, write by parts and in paragraphs.
2. Genre – It is a descriptive writing. You are expected to describe your experiences in the Drama Club and what you will miss about the club.
3. Language and formality – The tone and style should be casual and less formal as both the writer and the target readers are students. The language should be straightforward and simple words should be used as the target readers are new students, most of whom should be S.1 students.
4. Organisation – Write in paragraphs in response to the question in each part. In each part, start with a topic sentence, followed by details supported with examples, and end with a conclusion. You can use cohesive devices to link up the sentences and paragraphs to make the writing more organised.
5. Topic and vocabulary – The theme of this booklet entry is school clubs. You should have enough relevant ideas and vocabulary items for this topic. You can refer to the following ideas and vocabulary items.
