Answering Strategy

- 1. Text type and format You are asked to write a feature article. The content should be presented in paragraphs, including an opening, a main body and a closing. An attractive title should be included to catch the readers' attention.
- 2. Genre It is a descriptive and narrative writing. You are expected to write an article about a successful lyricist, describing her life experience with the difficulties she encountered and in what ways she was inspired to write lyrics.
- 3. Language and formality Both the writer and the target readers of the article are students so semi-formal language and a casual style can be adopted. As the article is about a lyricist, write in the third person to enhance the objectivity. You should use the past tenses to describe her life in the past and the present tenses when talking about present situations.
- 4. Organisation A title should come before the content. You may start the article by showing how successful the lyricist is today to arouse readers' interest. Then mention how she was inspired to write lyrics and trace her bitter life in the past.
- 5. Topic and vocabulary The theme of this article is the obstacles a lyricist faces in her life. You should have enough relevant ideas and vocabulary items for this topic. You can refer to the following ideas and vocabulary items.
