## **Answering Strategy**

- 1. Text type and format You are asked to write an argumentative essay. In an argumentative essay, the content should be in paragraphs, including an introduction, a main body and a conclusion.
- 2. Genre It is an argumentative and expository writing. You are expected to argue for joining a local internship or joining an oversea study tour.
- 3. Language and formality The essay is to show your preference and state your opinions and standpoint, so it should be objective and persuasive. The use of language should be quite formal as the essay is to be published in a newspaper. The arguments need to be strong and reasonable. To enhance the effect, you should also write in a convincing tone. The present tenses should be used most of the time as you are referring to situations in general.
- 4. Organisation Clearly show you stance in the first and the last paragraphs. In the main body, state the advantages of joining a local internship and the disadvantages of joining an overseas study tour, or vice versa. Elaborate your arguments with reasons and examples. You may compare and contrast the effectiveness between the two. Cohesive devices can be used to link up the sentences and paragraphs to make the essay more organised.
- 5. Topic and vocabulary The theme of this essay is local internship and overseas study tour. You should have enough relevant ideas and vocabulary items for this topic. You can refer to the following ideas and vocabulary items.
