## **Answering Strategy**

- 1. Text type and format You are asked to write an email to your teacher. At the beginning, you should address your teacher with 'Dear Miss Chan' and end your email with a semi-formal complimentary close like 'Best regards, Chris Wong'.
- 2. Genre It is a descriptive and expository writing. You are expected to provide information about your friend as well as explain certain ideas in the poem in order to help Miss Chan to assess your work.
- 3. Language and formality Since the target reader of the email is the writer's teacher, the language and tone should be polite and formal. Be straightforward in the email. You should also be humble since you are seeking advice and suggestions from her.
- 4. Organisation You should greet Miss Chan at the beginning of the email. In the first paragraph, state your purpose of writing. In the main body, tell her what has happened to your friend, and explain the content and techniques you adopted in the poem. Then, ask for her advice and express your gratitude for her help. End the email with your name or signature.
- 5. Topic and vocabulary The theme of this email is English poetry writing. You should have enough relevant ideas and vocabulary items for this topic. You can refer to the following ideas and vocabulary items.
