

### Answering Strategy

1. Text type and format – As the chairperson of the Debating Club, you are asked to write a profile for the club for the school yearbook. A title is recommended to be stated at the beginning in order to catch readers' attention.
2. Genre – It is a descriptive and expository writing. You are expected to tell readers about the objectives of the club, advantages of joining the club, its activities and achievements. As the profile will be published in the school yearbook, you may mention the success of the club and encourage students to join.
3. Language and formality – The profile is written as an introduction of the club to your fellow students. As the profile will be published in the school yearbook, formal language should be used. Concise and straightforward language should also be adopted to suit the context.
4. Organisation – You can start by describing the objectives of the club and the benefits of joining it. Then introduce to the readers some of the extra-curricular activities and achievements of the club last year. At last, appeal to schoolmates to join the club.
5. Topic and vocabulary – The theme of this profile is the features of a debating club. You should have enough relevant ideas and vocabulary items for this topic. You can refer to the following ideas and vocabulary items.
