## **Answering Strategy**

- 1. Text type and format You are asked to write the first chapter of a story. The title of the story should be stated at the beginning. Suspense can be created at the end of the first chapter to encourage readers to read further.
- 2. Genre It is a narrative and descriptive writing. You are expected to introduce the setting and the characters of the story, followed by the difficulties encountered by the characters as the rising action of the story. Climax or resolution is not a must as this is the first chapter of the story.
- 3. Language and formality As a story, the style of it should be informal and the language can be straightforward with some figurative language, e.g. onomatopoeia and personification. The past tenses should be used in a story.
- 4. Organisation A title should come before the content. The setting and the main characters should be introduced in the first paragraph. In the main body, describe the difficulties that need to be solved by the characters and how they try to tackle the difficulties. The chapter can be ended with suspense, e.g. the problems remain unsolved and what the characters plan to do next.
- 5. Topic and vocabulary The theme of this story is mystery. You should have enough relevant ideas and vocabulary items for this topic. You can refer to the following ideas and vocabulary items.
