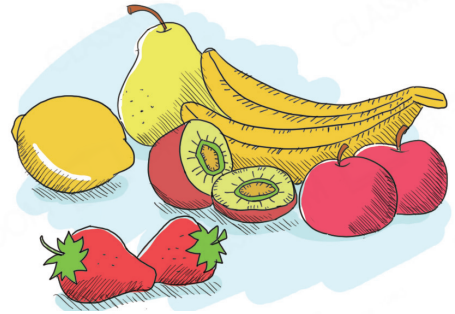
Encourage students to include these useful phrases and sentences in their writing.

Structure: clause, + especially + examples



e.g. I like all kinds of fruit, **especially** oranges and bananas.

Purpose: to introduce a reason

Structure: clause (result) + This is because + clause (reason)

e.g. I cannot afford to buy a new bicycle. **This is because** I have used up all my pocket money for buying reference books.
