**Out of** these kinds of food, seeds are its **favourite**.

Purpose: to emphasise the favourite item in a group

Structure: Out of + noun (plural), something + be + somebody's favourite

e.g. **Out of** all kinds of fruit, bananas are my **favourite**.

Purpose: to put actions in sequence

Structure: subject + action 1 + action 2 + action 3

e.g. The chef washed the vegetables, cut them into pieces **and** fried them in the frying pan.
