Purpose: to say what is unachievable or cannot be done

Structure: subject + be + too + adjective + (for something / somebody) + to-infinitive

e.g. This swimming pool is **too** deep **for** children **to** swim.

**Better still**, when given more opportunities for social contact with other dogs and humans, they tend to behave more properly.

Purpose: to give more satisfying information

Structure: Better still, + clause

e.g. Doing yoga helps people relax their muscles.  
**Better still**, it purifies their minds.

Fruits are tasty  
**Better still**, they help boost our health.
