**Intending to** bring the audience a different feeling, the drama puts the plot in a modern setting.

Purpose: to show the reason for something

Structure: Intending + to-infinitive, + clause



**e.g.** **Intending to** satisfy the overwhelming response, the organiser has decided to increase the entries for joining the marathon.
