Heading

- Clear and catchy, e.g. CAPITALISED or in **bold**
- Tell readers what the poster is about

Sub-heading

Give extra information, e.g. which organisation gives out the poster

Content

- Divide the content into parts
- Can write in point form for easy reading
- Use imperatives for rules or slogans, e.g. 'Do not run.'

Pictures

Include pictures or graphics to catch readers' attention

Closing

End with comments or a conclusion

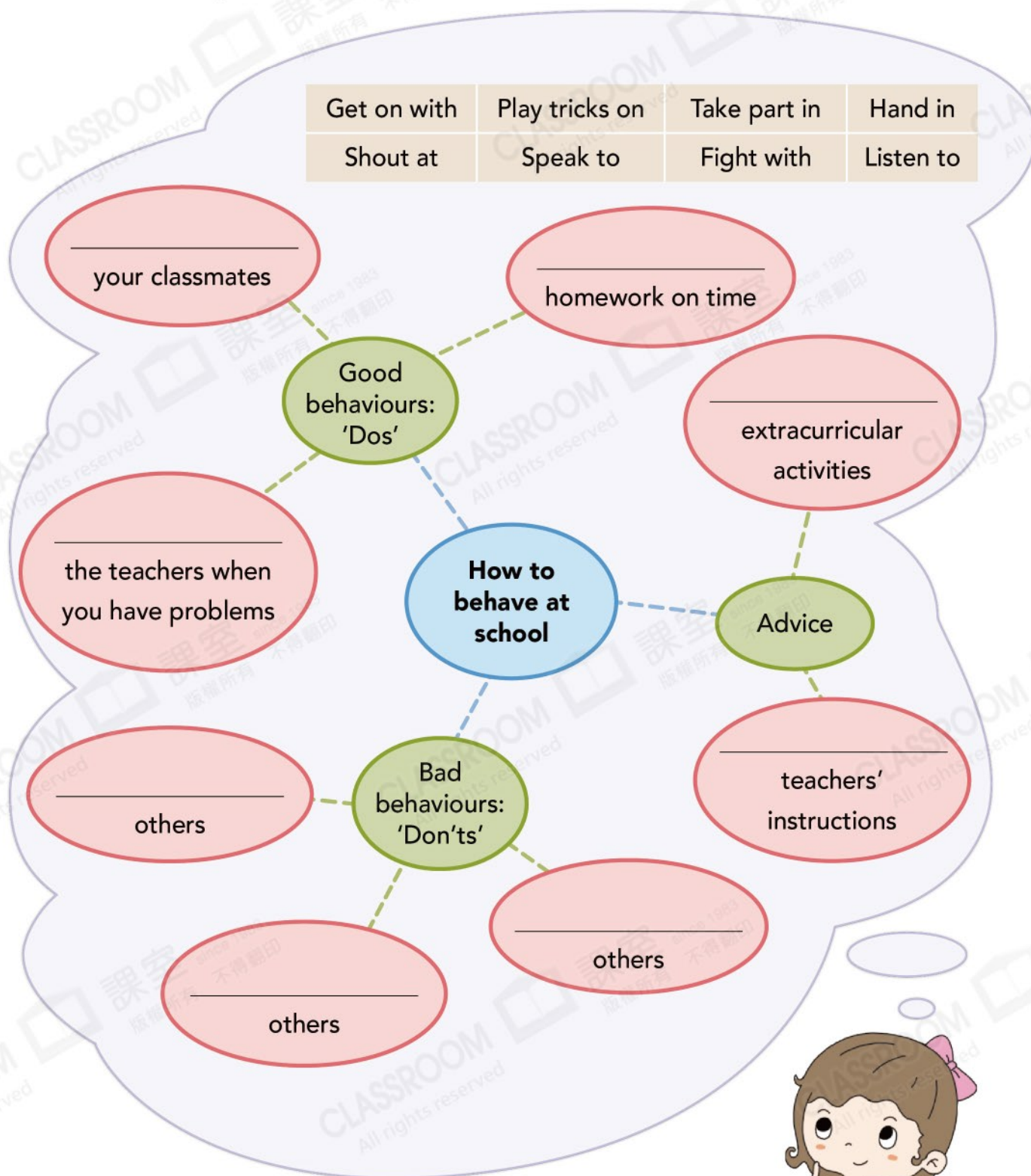

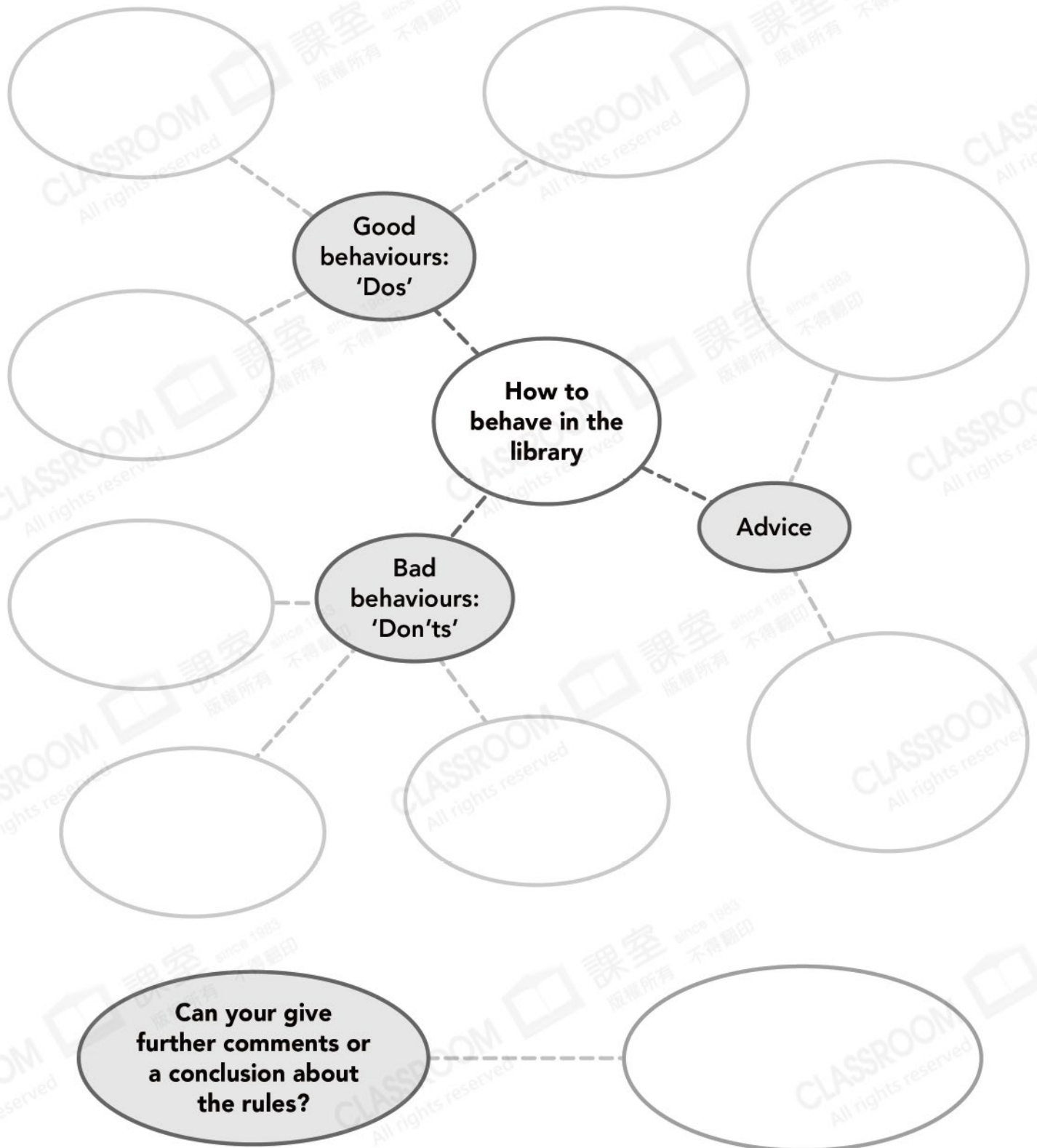
