


Sarah and her family are in a zoo. They are guessing some riddles about animals. Can you help solve the riddles?

When the subject (主語) is **third-person singular¹¹** in the **simple present tense¹²**, we add an extra '**-s**' or '**-es**' to the verb.

Sarah plays the piano and watches TV on Sundays.

For the negative statements, we add 'does not' to the verb instead¹³

Tiffany does not like coffee.

For the verbs to be and verbs to have, we change the form to

The baby is happy. She has a lot of toys to play with.
